



Discover Trelleborg on Sweden's south coast





Charming Trelleborg



Trelleborg has flourished on the Baltic coast. Over time, it has developed into a city shaped by its maritime heritage, and has taken its name from a Viking-era ring fortress.

In 1988, the remains of a **Viking fortress** were found in Trelleborg, and with this discovery the city's name got an explanation – “borg” means fortress in Swedish. The Trelleborg fortress is the only reconstructed Viking fortress in the world today.

The city centre is perfect for exploring on foot with a **walking street lined with shops, restaurants and outdoor cafés**. You can shop, experience some amazing artworks or just enjoy the bustling atmosphere.

The continental atmosphere prevails in Trelleborg, with Danish, German and Swedish cultures all meeting. Maybe you know Trelleborg as the “**City of Palms**”? Every summer 110 palm trees adorn the city's streets and squares.

The town square **Stortorget** is home to the old water tower, the statue of a sea serpent **Sjöormen** and the

Trelleborg museum. The museum's urban history exhibition “Stadsliif” provides insight into how the city has grown.

The city park **Stadsparken** is next to Stortorget – **it is the city's green oasis**, boasting over 100 different tree species and the newly renovated **Axel Ebbes Art Gallery**, as well as a playground, bird pond and sculptures. Enjoy live music from the stage several evenings a week during the summer.



Food lovers



Rolling grain fields, seafood delights and forest gold. Trelleborg is filled with locally sourced and produced delicacies. Discover, explore and indulge your tastebuds!

Hällåkra Winery will transport you to Provence. Stroll among the vines, dine at Vinoteket and enjoy a wine tasting. The orchard grows apples for John Taylor's "Dryg Cider".

At **Hallongården**, berries are grown, picked and cooked in abundance. You can pick your own and visit the café, farm shop and farm animals. In autumn and winter you can make candles and enjoy delicious waffles.

Hönsinge Craft Brewery handcrafts beer using carefully selected ingredients and water from the spring at **Jordberga Estate**. Both light beer and craft beer are sold at the farm shop.

Grönby Farm Charcuterie's amazing sourdough pizzas are topped with handmade charcuterie from the farm shop. They must be preordered, but they are worth it. Also available to take home.

In Skegrie, you'll find **Stenmarks Restaurang & Växthus**, the world's



most climate friendly restaurant building, where you can enjoy delicious craft pizzas.

Quench your thirst at **Sydkustens Farm Brewery** with delicious juice and local beer. The cider house sells old-fashioned apple juice around the clock and the farm shop sells craft beer.





The Plains Gallery



Shop in the city, surrounding villages or along the sparkling coast. Enjoy the mix of new, second-hand, charming and trendy goods.

Shops line the car-free streets in the city and can also be found in **Valen Mall**. **Signum**, **Milda Matilda**, **Puls**, **Vintage by K** and **Annies Home** entice with elegance and style, while **Rozzie** and **A Fish Named Fred** offer classic men's fashion. At **Krydderiet** you'll find wonderful gifts.

Head westwards and visit **Rumeriet** and **Unique4** before the countryside starts. Here you'll find **Slättarps Farm** – a unique meeting place where interior design, fashion and flowers coexist with meals and coffee available at **Lenzi Pure Food**.

The coast to the east of Trelleborg offers a string of charming shops. **Ting Ute & Inne**, **Albert och Jag** and **Agdas Countryshop** have goods for your home, garden and kitchen. Around Äspö you'll find **Ludvigslunds Skafferi**, **Äspö Retortorp**, **Swaffers Gårdsbutik** and **Magiska Hem &**

Trädgård. In Beddingestrand you will find **Pärlvägen 9**, **Tika**, **Strandblomman** and **Innergården 7**.

A countryside shopping trip will take you to **Ullahills Magasin** and **ZillaF** for fashion and home décor, while **Livex** has goods from the Mediterranean. At **Gränsboda Gård** you can buy locally produced meat and berries, as well as browse the farm shop. Find more seasonal boutiques on the Visit Trelleborg shopping map.

Outdoor enthusiasts



From the southern coastal fields to the hills in the north, or from east to west along Skåne's south coast, nature in Trelleborg is easily accessed for outdoor enthusiasts and fresh air lovers.

The historic natural and cultural landscape is varied, with breezy coastal meadows, rolling hills, lush fields, winding avenues and picturesque villages. You'll find **five nature reserves**, all with different characteristics.

Cyclists love the South Coast Trail, a national cycling trail that runs along the entire Skåne coast. Discover countryside gems along **local cycling paths**. They are all on the map and descriptions of cycling routes are available here: visittrelleborg.se/en/bike

Is walking more your thing? Hike the **Skåne Trail** through Trelleborg city and along the coast, or between Trelleborg and Fru Alstad. The section to Fru Alstad is a pilgrimage called "**Mariavägen**". visittrelleborg.se/en/skaneleden.

Time for a break, picnic or overnight stay? There are **shelters** in Albäck, Fru Alstad, Anderslöv, Klagstorp and Östra Torp. The "Cocoon" shelter in Östra Torp is a destination in itself and was built in 2022 during the **ARKNAT** architecture festival.

Bring your binoculars and discover charming songbirds, majestic birds of prey and everything in between along the coast and lakes. **Böringe Mad** boasts 20 hectares of wetlands that attract rare birds of prey to nest. visittrelleborg.se/en/birdwatching

Sports fishermen visiting Trelleborg often choose **coastal fishing** in hopes of catching a sea trout. Fishing is not included in Sweden's Right of Public Access but you are permitted to fish freely with handheld equipment along the coast, except at river mouths. Check fishing regulations in Skåne here: lansstyrelsen.se





Visit Smygehuk



55 degrees, 20 minutes and 13 seconds – the southernmost point in Sweden is worth a visit all year round. Experience the summer vibe of Smygehuk or enjoy the autumn sunsets or icy winter days.

The southernmost point has a barbeque area, photo spot, binoculars and a viewing platform where you can stand at the southernmost tip of Sweden – be careful not to get your feet wet!

A protected population of **adders** lives in the coastal meadows west of Smygehuk. You'll find a snake fence to protect them from the curious crowds between the Smyge Lighthouse and the popular harbour.

Smygehuk Lighthouse offers a breathtaking view of the sea and the plains. The lighthouse is often open for those who have the energy to climb the steps and next to the lighthouse you'll find **Red Sails Restaurant**.

If you get hungry when in Smygehuk, you'll find fantastic seafood at the **Smyge Smokehouse**, food and coffee at **Café Smyge** and **Café Smygeriet**

– a chocolate café with award winning chocolates.

In the summer, the old **Merchant's Warehouse** is filled with a delightful mix of creations from local artists and artisans. Here, you'll find local mementos from your visit to the southernmost point of Sweden. Next to the Merchant's Warehouse, you'll find **Södrast** and **Karlssons Antik** for some shopping.

In the summer, Smygehuk is filled with music and vibrant life. A favourite event is the sing-along "**Sveriges Sydligaste Allsång**" when well-known Swedish artists take to the stage on a handful of evenings each summer.

At Smygehuk, lime was historically quarried and burned in **kilns**. The oldest one is located between the harbor and the Merchant's Warehouse, with other kilns found northeast of Östra Torp.

Coastal dreams



The sea is a place of energy, happiness and quality of life in both big and small ways. From Trelleborg Harbour, a hub for imports and exports, to sunsets and views towards the unbroken horizon.

Trelleborg's harbour is Scandinavia's largest RoRo harbour and a hub for Swedish import and export. The harbour is currently being moved to the east to make room for **new residential areas** welcoming more people to a coastal lifestyle.

The closeness to the sea gives mild winters on the south coast and great conditions for golfers. **Tegelberga, Bedinge and Trelleborg Golfclub** offer great golfing opportunities. visittrelleborg.se/en/golf

Is it swimming that draws you to the south coast? **Dalabadet** is fantastic and close to the city and you can also camp at **Trelleborg Strand** and enjoy delicious food at **Siluett. Beddingstrand** has an idyllic shallow beach, and is close to **Pärlvägen 9**.

Check into coastal life at one of our characteristic accommodations.

Willow Hotel offers a spa, the restaurant **Meadow Brasserie**, the sky bar **Tapatcha**, and stunning views from its 16 floors.

Boutique hotel Dannegården is located in an impressive shipowner's villa from 1910 in central Trelleborg. Live like a lighthouse keeper at **Smygehuk Lighthouse** or be pampered at **Smygehus Havsbad** where you can enjoy the hotel's restaurant and spa and take a dip in the sea.





Adventure Seekers



Holidays and free time are fantastic for both big and small. Go on an adventure together with our best experiences for the whole family at your fingertips.

Challenge the family in Albäckskogen! Choose between **mountain bike trails** of varying difficulty, or if you want a quieter day, try your hand on the **DiscGolf course**. Don't forget your own bike, disc or regular Frisbee.

Recharge your batteries in cosy Beddingestrand. Here you'll find a **waffle café** offering both sweet and savoury waffles as well as ice cream, and coffee of course for those needing caffeine.

In addition to boats and docks, Skåre has a **snorkelling trail** that takes you on an adventure through the marine nature reserve. West of the fishing village, there is a **playground** and **viewing platform** where you can spot seals and seabirds.

Central Trelleborg is home to **Generationsparken** with a **skate-**

park, boules court, and outdoor gym. There is also a **dog park** that is close to the shops and cafés if you feel like grabbing a bite to eat.

Our youngest friends aged 0-3 can enjoy their own adventure along **Trelleborg Museum's crawling trail**. Here, six interactive stations have been installed at crawl height among the museum's permanent exhibitions.

History Fans



People have lived along Skåne's south coast for thousands of years. Join us on a journey through the millennia and learn about the fascinating cultural heritage.

The Viking fortress Trelleborgen has been partially reconstructed in the heart of the modern city, on its exact original site. The fortress is surrounded by a park with a Viking village, medieval houses, and a museum with the exciting multimedia exhibition "The Fortress by the Sea". During the summer, the Viking village comes to life and events, including the huge "Battle of Trelleborgen", take place one after another.

Gislöv Harbour has a unique **museum harbour** with clinker-built boats from the Skåne coast. This building method dates back to the Viking Age and is a UNESCO-listed intangible cultural heritage. Take a break at **Stetti Café & Bistro** and soak up the maritime environment.

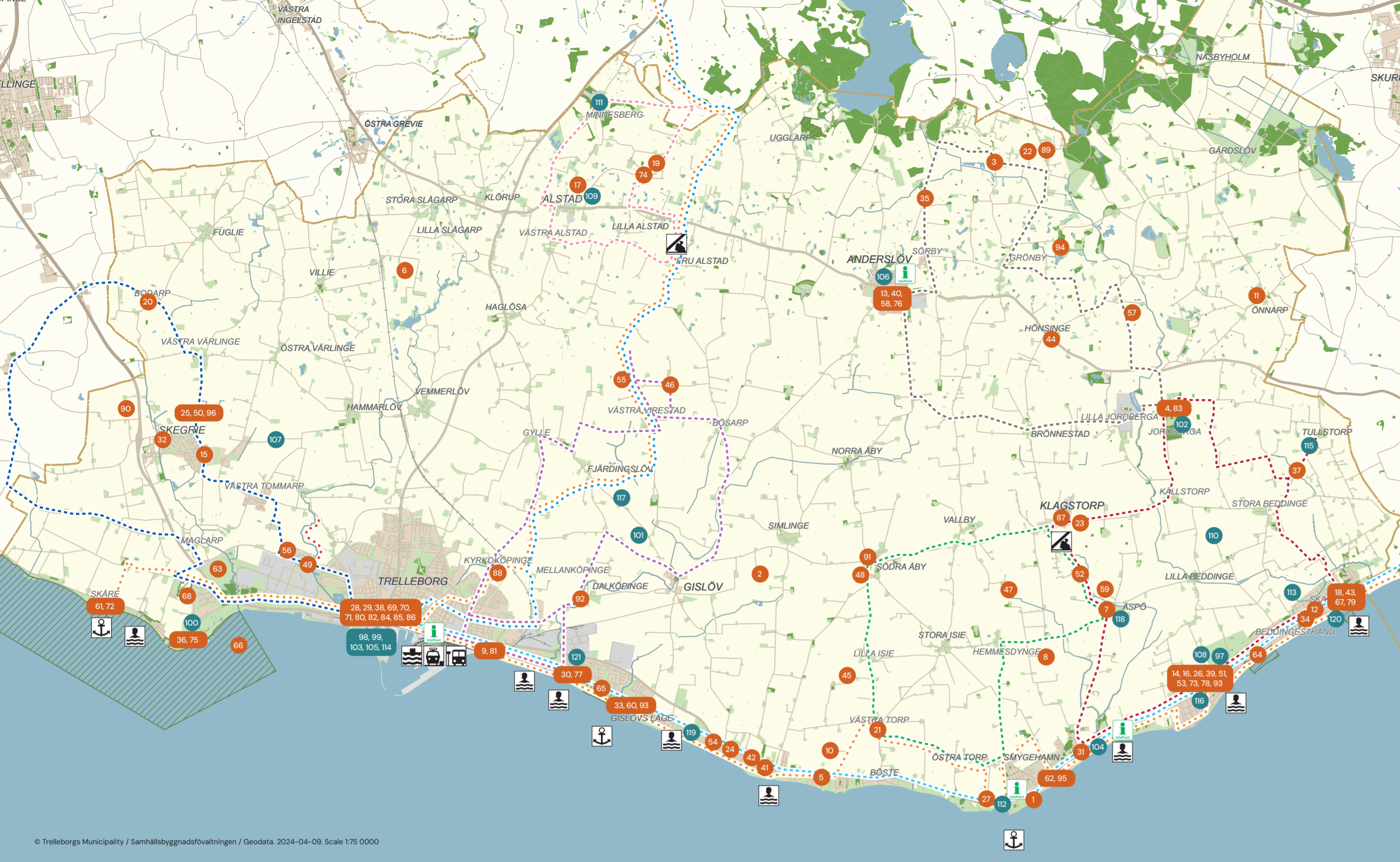
People discovered the beauty of life

on Sweden's southern coast over 7,000 years ago. Get to know the area's first inhabitants in the "Eye to Eye" exhibition at **Trelleborg Museum**, with artifacts and reconstructions from the famous Skateholm settlement. Then visit Skateholm where there is a viewing platform overlooking the settlement area and wetlands at Tullstorpsån.

Uniform Collection is Sweden's only museum with civilian and military uniforms from the 20th century. It also has costumes and props from well-known Swedish film and TV productions.

For those interested in military history, follow the **Per Albin path** along the coast to find remains of fortresses and defences from WWII or visit the **Northern Cemetery's** foreign cemetery and monument from WWI.

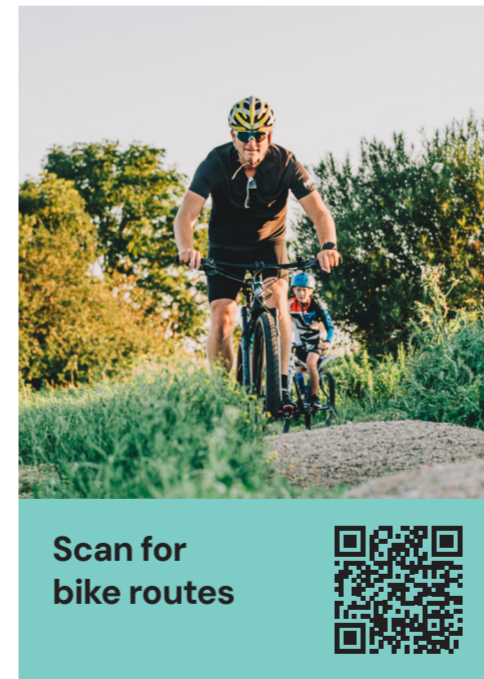

Sydkustleden follows the coastline in Trelleborg municipality. It is Sweden's third national cycling route and offers wonderful sea views.
- Skåre Snorkeling trail**
East of Skåre, there is a snorkelling trail that takes you into the marine nature reserve.
